

Getting started with Kanopy for public library users

To use Kanopy, you'll need to enter your library card information and create a Kanopy account. We recommend doing this in a web browser, but you can also set up your account in the Kanopy app for <u>iOS</u> or <u>Android</u>.

To get started with Kanopy in a web browser:


- 1. Go to www.kanopy.com in a supported browser (see page 4).
- 2. Select Get started.



3. Select Find your library.








4. To find a library near you, share your location when prompted or search for your library by name, city, or postcode. Select your library's name from the list or map, then click **Select this library**.




5. Enter your library card number and PIN or password (if required by your library). Then, select **Continue**.





- 6. Create your Kanopy account:
 - Enter your name, email address, and pass/word, then select **Sign up**.
 - Or, sign up with an existing Apple or Google account by selecting **Sign Up with Apple** or **Sign Up with Google** and following the instructions.





Supported browsers and devices

Web browsers

On a Windows computer, Mac, or Chromebook, you can use Kanopy in your web browser at <u>kanopy.com</u>. We recommend using the latest version of Chrome, Safari, Firefox, or Edge. An internet connection is required to watch films on Kanopy.

Mobile devices

You can download the Kanopy mobile app on supported mobile devices:

- <u>iPhones/iPads</u> with iOS 12.0+ (get it from the <u>Apple App Store</u>)
- Android devices with Android 7.1+ (get it on Google Play)
- Amazon Fire tablets with FireOS 6+ (get it from the Amazon Appstore)

Note: Video playback is not supported in mobile device browsers. Use the mobile app for the best Kanopy experience on mobile devices.

You can download the Kanopy TV app on supported smart TVs:

- Android TV and Google TV with Android 7.1+
- Apple TV with tvOS 12.0+
- Fire TV with FireOS 6+
- Roku with RokuOS 12.5+
- Samsung TV with <u>Tizen 6.5+</u>
