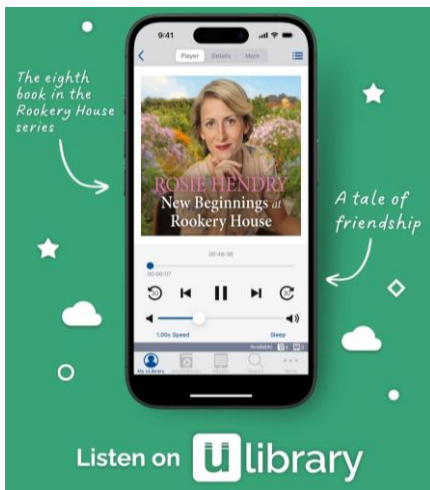
Librarian's Message

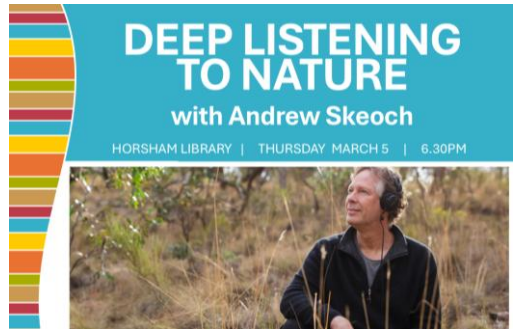
HORSHAM: Deep Listening to Nature with Andrew Skeoch

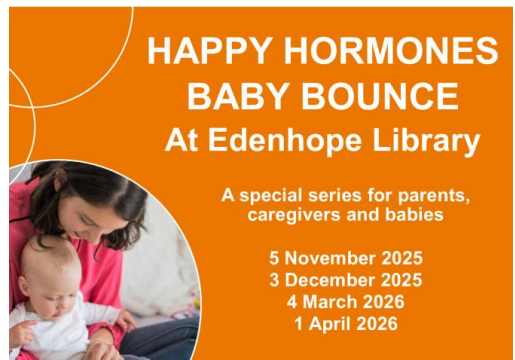

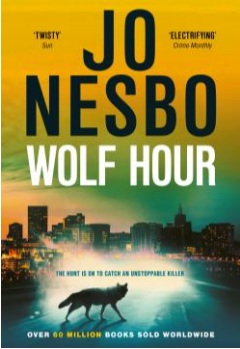

On The Edge by Kate Horan



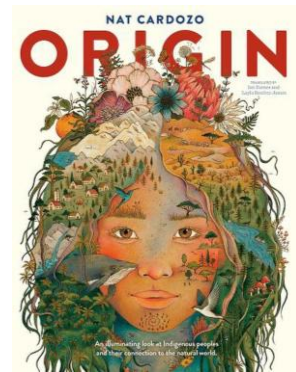
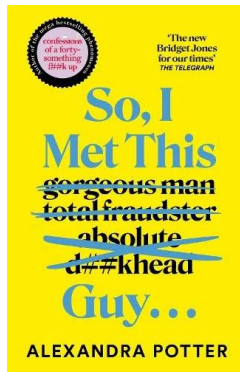
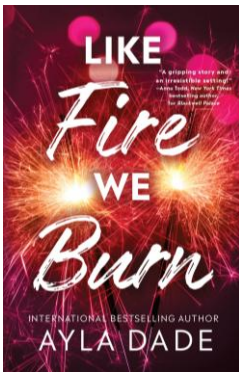
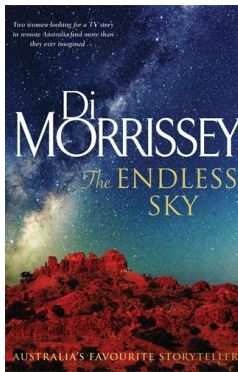
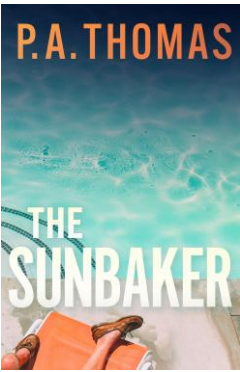
Sixteen years ago, teenage Maddie Marshall—vibrant, headstrong, and the only daughter of a high-profile politician—was found dead on a desolate beach near her hometown of Carrinya. The case shocked the small community but was never solved. Maddie’s best friend, Nel Foley, was the last person to see her alive and became the focus of vicious rumours, forcing her to leave town and never look back. Now 32 and working as a city GP, Nel returns after her father’s sudden death, determined to settle his affairs quickly. But when she reluctantly takes over his medical clinic, she reconnects with the town and meets Sophie Warner. Sophie’s husband Ryan, now a respected real estate agent, was Maddie’s boyfriend, and Nel has always suspected he was involved in her death. As Nel begins digging into the past, she uncovers secrets far more complicated, and dangerous, than she ever imagined.

Wolf Hour by Jo Nesbo



This killer has a story and he wants the world to hear it. When a small-time crook is shot dead on a Minneapolis street, all signs point to a lone sniper who vanishes without a trace. But this isn’t random violence. When the shooter strikes again, maverick detective Bob Oz is called in, and it quickly becomes clear the body count is only just beginning. As fear spreads and the killer edges closer to the spotlight, Oz realises this murderer isn’t just killing. He’s sending a message. The deeper Oz digs, the more sinister the pattern becomes, and the more unsettled he feels. Because the mind behind the murders feels disturbingly familiar. As the case spirals into dark personal and political territory, Oz is forced to confront a chilling possibility: to catch this killer, he may have to face the parts of himself he’s spent a lifetime trying to outrun.
